- Support the vision, bylaws, policies and procedures of the CTC Walk to Emmaus Board of Directors.
- Attend Board Meetings on the third Saturday of January, March, July, September, and November of each year.
- Attend Board Member Training.
- Participate as an active, working member of a Standing Committee of the Board.
- Be active in Fourth Day Group Gatherings, presenting information from the Board to the members of the Emmaus Community.
- Serve as a Board Representative as needed after attending Board Member Training. (Clergy members serve as Spiritual Directors or Assistant Spiritual Directors).
- Serve as a Community Advising Board Member as needed.
- Attend Candlelight Worship services
- Attend Conference Gatherings.
